The Diocesan School Board welcomes back Fr. Joe Corpora!

Fr. Joe served the Diocese of Phoenix from 1990- 2002 in many capacities. As Pastor of St. John Vianney he founded the first Catholic school to be opened in the Diocese of Phoenix in 30 years (St. John Vianney Catholic School). Fr. Joe was active in the community and worked tirelessly to raise money to assist those who needed help. His outreach was especially meaningful to the very poor of Mexico and to youth at risk. It was not unheard of Fr. Joe to bike, run, swim even box in order to raise money for the projects he cared about. He was appointed to the Diocesan School Board, Presbyteral Council and served on a variety of community boards and special task forces throughout the valley. After leaving Phoenix, Fr. Joe became Pastor of Holy Redeemer Parish in Portland, Oregon. He built the first “green” building of any Catholic school in the nation and renovated and restored the church. He served on several archdiocesan committees and still had time to run a few marathons to raise money for his parish and school!

Just this summer Fr. Joe began his latest assignment at the University of Notre Dame as part of the Alliance for Catholic Education (ACE) team. He has been asked to head up a special task force to help look at strategies to encourage Latinos to send their children to Catholic schools

Fr. Joe’s goodness and passion for serving others has clearly made a difference in the Diocese of Phoenix and he continues to do so today more than ever.
