Continuing Education Requirements

The Diocese of Phoenix has some requirements for all volunteers who wish to serve in liturgical ministries. The purpose of continuing education is to allow those who serve to continue to nurture their spiritual growth with quality education about the faith. In addition, the “Called to Protect” training allows us to be more aware of ways to keep those we serve in ministry safe!

EM's and Lectors

EM's and Lectors must complete “Called to Protect” training every two years and six (6) hours of continuing education every year.

Ministry of Care

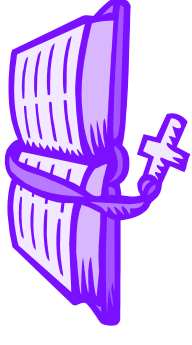
EM's to the Homebound and Hospitalized must complete “Called to Protect” training every year and six (6) hours of continuing education every year.

Question Box

- Q:* Does my “Called to Protect” training count towards my six hours of continuing education?
- A:* In most cases, YES! Any in-person “Called to Protect” training counts toward your six hours. The online renewal classes DO NOT count for the six hours!

Other Volunteers

All other volunteers must complete “Called to Protect” training every two years. Other volunteers are encouraged to take as many continuing education courses as they like, to foster their continued growth in the faith!
