

NDP Senior Class Picnic Details:

For: All NDP senior class students only

Permission Slips: All students must have a permission slip signed by a parent or guardian in order to board the bus and attend the picnic. The school will provide these permission slips prior to the day of the picnic.

Date: Monday April 6th

Time: Approximately 9:00 am. to 1:00 p.m. Seniors will arrive on time at NDP for A period where attendance will be taken. They will then be transported to the park by bus.

Location: Scottsdale Ranch Park located at 10400 E. Via Linda. This is a large park and our event will be located directly adjacent to the volleyball courts, restrooms and ramada numbers 5,6 and 7, which are reserved for NDP that day.

Attire: Seniors may wear casual clothes like shorts and t-shirts, however, girls should not wear short shorts, halters, or expect to hang out in their bathing suits, and boys will be required to keep shirts on even if they get hot and sweaty playing volleyball☺. Seniors should remember to apply sunscreen as they will be outside for several hours.

Transportation: Students will be transported by NDP buses from the school campus to and from the park. Students are not allowed to bring their own vehicles to the park and are not allowed to be dropped off or picked up at the park. All transportation will be via bus from the NDP Campus in the morning and back to the NDP campus in the afternoon.

Food and Beverages: A small breakfast treat will be served upon arrival at the park, snacks and drinks will be available all day long and a luncheon catered by NDP parent Brandon Maxwell of Michael's Catering will be served at noon. The food is for students only and the few teachers who will also be in attendance to help supervise.
